<p>ወ/ሮ ሊ ሴት ልጅዋ ትምህርት ሲት በምትውልበት ቀን የአንቲባዮቲክ መድሃኒትን መውሰድ አንድተተጥል ትፈልጋለች። የትምህርት ሲት ነርስ ለማናነጋገር ትደውላለች።</p>	<p>Mrs. Li needs her daughter to keep taking her antibiotics during the day while she is at school. She calls the school to talk to the school nurse.</p>
<p>ልጅዎ መድሃኒት ወደ ትምህርት ሲት መውሰድ አስፈላጊ ከሆነ የትምህርት ሲት ነርስ ማነጋገር አልብም። አንገሊዘኛ መናገር የሚያስችገረዎ ከሆነ ከነርስ ጋር ቀጥታ መነጋገር አንዲችሉ ትምህርት ሲት አስተርጓሚ ያቀርብልዎታል። የትምህርት ሲት ነርስ የማያውቁት ማንኛውንም መድሃኒት ልጅዎ በፍጹም ወደ ትምህርት ሲት መውሰድ የለበትም።</p>	<p>If your child needs to take medicine to school, you must contact the school nurse. If you are not comfortable speaking English, the school will provide an <i>interpreter</i> for you, so that you can talk directly with the nurse. Your child should never take <i>any</i> medicine to school that the nurse does not know about.</p>
<p>ወ/ሮ ሊ ለልጅዋ የምትሰጠውን መድሃኒት ትክክለኛውን መጠን በመለካት በጣም ጠንቃቃ ነች። ምክንያቱም ልጆች በሰውነት መጠን ከአወቂዎች አነስ ስለሚሉ ከተመሳሳይ መድሃኒት አብዛኛውን ጊዜ አንስተኛ መጠን ነው የሚያስፈልጋቸው።</p> <p>መድሃኒት ለልጅዎ ለመስጠት መመሪያውን በጣም በጥንቃቄ ይከተሉ። ለትንንሽ ልጆች እና ሀፃናት መድሃኒት አንደት አንደሚሰጥ አንዲያስይዎት ነርስ ይጠይቁ።</p>	<p>Mrs. Li is careful to measure out the correct dosage for her daughter’s medicine. Because children are smaller in size than adults, they usually need less of the same medicine.</p> <p>Follow the instructions for giving medicine to your children very carefully. Ask the nurse to show you how to give medicine to very small children and babies.</p>
